1. To get started with your Situational Judgement Exercise (SJE), please download the SJE FAQs/Tips at https://advancingexpertcare.org. Select the Certification Tab, Credentials, and the APRN or RN link to download the document (found under Hospice and Palliative Accrual for Recertification).

CREATING YOUR ACCOUNT (If you have NOT previously registered for a PSI account)

- 2. Please follow steps 2-7 to complete your registration. To start, register through the PSI E-Store at http://store.lxr.com. If you have already registered, please move to Step 8.
- 3. Select Login under E-Store Heading and select "No, I am a new shopper."
- 4. Input all required information to create a login and password.
- 5. Access your email to retrieve the registration email.
- 6. You will receive an email sent to you from LXROrders@goAMP.com, click the link in the email to activate your account.

Explanation: Mrs. Martinez is exhibiting acute symptoms in a long term care facility. This procedure is likely not available and not a critical first step in your initial assessment.

Mrs. Martinez is unable to cooperate with the physical examination. She means when turned and her breathing is slightly labored. Her lungs are positive for rhenchi bilaterally that clear will cough. WBC count is 14.2, but other lab values are normal. Her medication history includes the following:

Donepezil 5 mg po every night; memantine 5 mg po daily; quetiapine 25 mg (1/2 tablet by mouth every morning and 2 tablets every morning prn agitation); lorazepam 0.5 mg (1/2 by mouth hrs prn anxiety); hydrocodone/acetaminophen 5/325 mg (1 tablet q 6 hrs prn pain); trazodone HCl 50 mg (1/2 tablet bid for mood).
